Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that claim of the petitioner for regularization has been considered but the pay and pension has not been re-fixed, whereas, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the husband of the petitioner has been considered at par with other 409 persons who have been regularized.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing has been conveyed to the petitioner.

In view of submission made by learned counsel for the parties, respondent-State is directed to communicate the order in view of the ratio of judgment passed in CWP No. 21694 of 2013 and also after considering the claim of other similarly situated persons who have already been considered for regularization and other benefits.

A detailed and reasoned order be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of four weeks.

In case, the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner, she is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
