The writ petition bearing CWP No.904 of 2011 filed by the petitioner was disposed of vide order dated 08.11.2013 (**Annexure P-7**), directing the respondent-Bank to regularize the service of the petitioner with effect from the date, his alleged junior-Yoginder Kumar Yadav had been extended the benefit with all other consequential benefits within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of that order.

In the present contempt petition, allegation is regarding violation of the aforesaid directions.

From the written statement filed, it is clear that Yoginder Kumar Yadav has been regularized in the rank of Peon w.e.f. 19.12.2003 and an identical relief of regularization with effect from the same date has been extended to the petitioner herein. As regards prayer for promotion obtained by Yoginder Kumar Yadav to the cadre of Clerk w.e.f. 09.12.2013, the reply is that as per the statutory Regulations, the employees are required to pass a written test with a required standard to earn the promotion. The

petitioner, concededly, to date, has not cleared that written examination.

In view of the above, no case for interference in the present contempt petition is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed and the rule is discharged.
