Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 30.11.2015, passed by the apex court.

Admittedly, during the pendency of the writ petition, possession was handed over to the petitioner after completion of necessary formalities. Petitioner still has a grouse, however, that he has been asked to pay much more than the amount that was due. According to Mr. Mittal, representation in this regard was sent to the Chief Administrator on 01.09.2016. The petitioner has highlighted therein the manner in which calculation ought to have been made.

Mr. Chauhan at this stage submits that the representation shall be considered and a speaking order shall be passed within three months from today.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary under the contempt jurisdiction.
