On the last date of hearing, following orders were passed in

“Pursuant to order dated March 21, 2017,
respondent Nos. 1 to 3 are present in court. Mr.Dutt has
sought instructions from them and submits that
answering respondents have not violated the order.
They are not using the trademark 'Super King' at
present. The name 'Super King' is not being used on
any of the 'Flex Board', bill books etc by the
respondents in any manner. Counsel for the petitioner
prays for a short adjournment to verify this contention.
Two weeks time is granted.

Personal appearance of the respondents,
except respondent No.1 is exempted.”

It appears that respondents are not using trademark 'Super

King' on any of the 'Flex Board', bill book etc. No cause of action thus, survives in this petition.

Disposed of.

Petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival in case any cause of action survives.
