In the writ petition bearing CWP No. 27304 of 2013 filed by the petitioners, this Court vide order dated 01.10.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) passed the following operative directions:-

“ In view of the above, the petitioners are held entitled to the grant of arrears w.e.f. 1.4.2010 as granted by this Court to identically situated persons with all other consequential benefits.

The arrears be calculated and paid to the petitioners within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands allowed in the above terms. .”

Upon notice, a reply has been filed from which the inevitable conclusion is that the abovesaid order dated 01.10.2015 (**P-1**) has been

complied with as the benefits admissible to the petitioners have been granted.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioners concedes that the present petition has become infructuous.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
