Affidavit filed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga is taken on record. It has been mentioned therein that challan had been prepared on 03.02.2017 on the basis of the investigation and that the police had tried to present the challan before the learned Court but due to absence of accused, the Court refused to accept the challan. The police has made best efforts to inform the accused about presentation of challan but in vain. In the meantime, an application was filed by the accused party before the Inspector General of Police, Bathinda as such inquiry was conducted by the Superintendent of Police, Moga. After completion of the inquiry, Kulwinder Kaur, Sukhchain Singh, Jagsir Singh and Murti Kaur were found to be innocent and certain offences were deleted by addition of some other offences and at present, the challan has been prepared and presented in the Court on 18.07.2017.

In view of the above said circumstances, no further action is warranted. No contempt is made out as *prima facie* there is no willful disobedience of the order.

Disposal of this petition will not in any manner prejudice the right of the petitioner to avail any other legal remedy.
