This contempt petition has been filed on the ground that order dated 11.02.2015 (Annexure P-5) passed in Civil Revision No.8097 of 2014 has been violated.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that not only threat was given but injury was also caused to the petitioner and the interim order passed in favour of the petitioner has been violated.

Admittedly, the petitioner-plaintiff filed a civil suit for declaration. Along with the suit, an application under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 CPC was also filed, which was dismissed by the trial Court. Thereafter, appeal filed against that order was also dismissed. Aggrieved by said two orders, the petitioner filed Civil Revision No.8097 of 2014, which is stated to be pending before this Court.

By considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, no contempt is made out only on the ground that threat was given and injury was caused to the petitioner. Moreover, the status quo with regard to possession was there. It is not a case of the petitioner that he has been dispossessed.

Accordingly, no case is made out for initiation of contempt proceedings and the present petition is dismissed.
