Petitioner has filed the present contempt petition under Section 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Court Act 1971 for violating the order dated 28.11.2013 passed by this Court in CWP No.15874 of 2003 (P-1) whereby respondents were directed to recalculate the arrears as admissible to the petitioner on account of the order being passed now and to pay the same as expeditiously as possible but not later than six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of order. Since the compliance of the order was not made, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice learned Counsel for the respondent states that the order dated 28.11.2013 (P-1) has been fully complied with and the necessary payments have been made.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the

order dated 28.11.2013 (P-1) has not been fully complied with.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, if the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he shall be free to seek revival of the present petition.
