JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Petitioner has sought initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Court Act 1971 for violating the order dated 18.05.2016 (P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.2360 of 2016 whereby respondents were directed to release the payment of the petitioner as early as possible but preferably within a period of two months, if already not released. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Amarjit Singh Gill, Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitation Division, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, respondent no.4.

At the time of hearing today, learned State Counsel submits that

on recalculation the remaining amount payable would be Rs.1,29,248.71/- which has been paid by way of cross cheque to the learned Counsel for the petitioner in the Court today.

In response learned Counsel for the petitioner has raised some dispute regarding the amount. However, he does not oppose the disposal of the present contempt with liberty to the petitioner to seek his remedy to claim the remaining amount in accordance with law.

Disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
