DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 21.12.2016 passed in ***CRM-M-45645 of 2016***. Said order was to be complied with within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petitioners have approached this Court by way of filing the present contempt petition on the ground that the said order has not been complied with and notice of motion in the case was issued on 27.01.2017.

In response to notice of motion, the reply has been filed, which is on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the representation filed by the petitioners was disposed of vide order dated

30.12.2016. Certain facts were not mentioned in the petition and there is a concealment on the part of the petitioners. However, keeping in view the directions issued by this Court, a direction has been issued to SHO concerned for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

While dictating this order, learned counsel for the petitioners has brought to the notice of this Court that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

By considering the compliance made by respondents as well as the compromise arrived at between the parties, the present petition is disposed of.
