Vide order dated November 17, 2010, Jai Narain was granted interim relief to the effect that his dispossession shall remain stayed till further orders.

The present petitioner is Rampal who was impleaded as respondent No.4 in the writ petition. The petitioner has filed this contempt petition alleging that Jai Narain in the garb of order dated November 17, 2010 encroached upon more land than the land in which he could claim possession.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case. It is not a case of willful disobedience or breach of any undertaking as such prima facie no contempt is made out.

The petition is disposed of. However, it will be open to the petitioner to file a misc. application in CWP No. 20408 of 2010, in case there has been any misuse/ abuse by petitioner Jai Narain or there is any act of usurping the property in the garb of the order dated November 17, 2010.
