The petitioner claims that order dated 31.10.2013, requiring the respondents to consider the legal notices has not been complied with. A perusal of order Annexure P2, indicates that a detailed speaking order has been passed by the Director, Urban Local Bodies, Haryana, Chandigarh on 7.3.2014.

Grievance of the petitioner is that post of Sanitary Inspector has been lying vacant and the petitioner is not being promoted to the said post. It appears that the petitioner is claiming relief beyond the scope of the legal notice which had been sent by him in 2013 and stands considered vide order dated 7.3.2014, Annexure P2. Prima facie, there does not appear to be any wilful disobedience of any order passed by this Court. In case the petitioner has got any grievance regarding non-consideration of his name for promotion to any post, it is always open to the petitioner to avail any other remedy available to him in accordance with law.

Disposed of with above observations.
