Petitioner-Dr. Kuldip Singh has filed the present contempt petition under Sections 10, 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 seeking initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for willfully disobeying the orders dated 03.03.2016 and 03.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.20091 of 2015 whereby office orders in terms of the recommendations of the DPC relating to the promotion of petitioner as Associate Professor (Bio Chemistry) were ordered to be issued.

The main petition already stands adjourned to **31.05.2017**.

In the meanwhile **CM No.7808-CII of 2017** has been moved seeking preponement of the date of hearing or in the alternative seeking issuance of directions to respondents to issue promotion order of the petitioner to the post of Professor in Biochemsitry on the basis of DPC held

on 17.03.2017.

At the time of hearing, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the present CM as well as main petition both have become infructuous as the respondents have granted the relief sought by the petitioner by way of the present petition.

In view of the above, the aforesaid CM is allowed and date of hearing is preponed from 31.05.2017 to today itself and aforesaid CM as well as the contempt petition are hereby dismissed as infructuous.
