JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioner was appointed as a Lady Attendant on 03.10.2004 on contract basis, initially for a period of one year with the Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS), Polyclinic, Muktsar. Her services were terminated vide order dated 04.09.2014, which was challenged by the petitioner by filing CWP No.19518 of 2014. The said petition was allowed vide order dated 08.10.2015 (**Annexure P-1**).

It was contended that the petitioner has not been reinstated in compliance of the aforesaid orders.

Upon notice, learned Counsel for the respondents submits that vide order dated 10.03.2017, the petitioner has been reinstated as temporary contractual appointee at the ECHS, Polyclinic, Muktsar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
