The petitioner-Manpreet Singh along with his wife-Jaspreet Kaur had filed CRM-M No.21992 of 2016 seeking directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents/relatives of Jaspreet Kaur (wife). The said petition was disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of one month and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It was also made clear that the said order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent submits that the present contempt petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions have already been complied with.

Upon notice, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes the aforesaid submission.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
