DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Vide order dated 2.12.2013 passed by this Court, the respondents were directed to look into and redress the grievances of the petitioner-association in accordance with law as early as possible but not later than four months from the date of receipt of supplementary representation.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 contends that order dated 2.12.2013 has been complied with.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner contends

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that the order has not been complied in its true spirit as the grievance of the petitioner-association has not been properly redressed.

Since the direction was only to consider the grievance of the petitioner-association, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

In case the petitioner-association is not satisfied, he is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
