Petitioner has preferred this contempt petition under Section 12 read with Section 2-A of the Contempt of Courts Act for punishing the respondent for willfully and deliberately disobeying the order passed by this Court in CWP No.7872 of 2014 titled as Azad Singh Vs. State of Haryana & Ors. whereby encroachments were ordered to be removed by the concerned authorities qua the whole town and not confined to any particular area alone.

Upon notice learned State Counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit dated 10.01.2017 of S.K. Chauhan, Executive Officer, Municipal Council Jind depicting the exact number of encroachments removed and the remaining qua which the process is going on and submits

that the order dated 28.04.2014 passed in CWP No.7872 of 2014 has been duly complied with.

In view of the aforesaid, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing survives in the present contempt petition.

In view of the agreed stand of the parties, present petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
