There are 07 petitioners-retirees who were claiming the arrears of Leave Encashment and Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity in terms of the order dated 23.03.2012 passed in CWP No.3672 of 2012 read with order dated 05.01.2012 in CWP No.23138 of 2010 and order dated 25.11.2014 passed in COCP No.3481 of 2012.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Sukhwinder Singh, Supdt. Office of Director Animal Husbandry, Punjab, Chandigarh submits that all arrears of DCRG and leave encashment have been paid to all the petitioners and as such the present petition has become infructuous, which fact has been conceded to by learned Counsel

for the petitioners.
