Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 24.8.2016.

Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by directing respondent No.3 to take a decision on the representation dated 3.3.2016 (Annexure P/10) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. It is further directed that in case the petitioners are found entitled to the refund of amount, the same be released to them within next one month, in accordance with law.”

Notice of motion.

On the asking of court, Mr.Rohit Arya, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana. He submits that contempt shall be purged at the earliest. In view of this statement, petition is disposed of. In case, order is not complied with within three weeks from today, petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition. In such eventuality, this court shall consider imposition of exemplary costs on the officers responsible for delay/non compliance.
