Petitioner has preferred this contempt petition under Section 12 of the contempt of Courts Act for not complying with the undertaking dated 28.05.2013 and violating the order dated 28.05.2013 passed by the Court of Civil Judge(Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana in a pending civil suit between the parties.

At this stage learned Counsel for the respondent submits that compliance of the order dated 28.05.2013 has been made by getting done necessary repairs in the suit premises which is further fortified from the statement of respondent-Amar Singh and order passed by Civil Judge(Jr. Divn.), Ludhiana both dated 28.05.2013 respectively dismissing the suit filed by the plaintiff-petitioner Harvinder Kaur as infructuous.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
