The petitioner had filed CWP No.5590 of 2016 seeking directions to the respondents to make the payment of the pending bills. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 18.05.2016 with a direction to the respondents to release the payment of the petitioner as early as possible preferably within a period of two months. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Learned Counsel for the respondent/M.C. makes a statement at bar that the entire due payments have since been released to the petitioner, which is not disputed by learned Counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
