JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The writ petition bearing *CWP No. 9307 of 2014* filed by the petitioner, seeking, *inter alia*, release of her agricultural land measuring 34 *kanals* situated in the Revenue Estate of Village Para, Tehsil & District Rohtak, in view of under Section 24 (2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, was disposed of vide order dated 19.05.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) with the directions to the appropriate authority to decide the detailed and comprehensive representation to be filed by the petitioner within a period two months by passing a speaking order.

Since the needful was not done within the prescribed time,
hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, the reasons for delay in implementing the order in question have been furnished. However, a speaking order dated 12.05.2016 (**Annexure R-1/1**) in compliance of the directions dated 19.05.2015 (**P-1**) stands passed by the competent authority.

In view of the aforesaid facts, no case for continue the present contempt is made out, accordingly, present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
