Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the services of the petitioner have been regularized in view of order passed in CWP No.2552 of 2014 but the arrears have not been released to him only on the ground that he is not having any GPF Account Number or PRAN Number which is required for having benefit Under New Pension Scheme. He has also received communication dated 11.01.2017, which is Annexure P8, wherein it is clearly mentioned that arrears will be disbursed to the petitioner as soon as he is issued GPF or PRAN Number.

In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction that the needful be done within a period of two weeks and, thereafter, the arrears be deposited in the account of the petitioner within one month. In case, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to approach the Competent Authority for his grievance and the same shall be considered by the concerned officer.
