Learned counsel for the respondents-State on instructions from Dr. Rajinder Kumar, Deputy Civil Surgeon, Karnal submits that it was only the petitioner who did not come to have possession of the ultra sound machine whereas learned counsel for the petitioner submits that machine was never handed over to her and she is ready to have the possession of the machine now also.

Respondent No.3 is directed to deliver the sealed machine at the registered premises and respondent No.2 is directed to un-seal the machine and hand over the same to the petitioner within a period of ten days. In case the compliance of the order is not made then petitioner is at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
