Petitioners have preferred the instant contempt petition under Section 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondent for not complying with the order dated 28.09.2012 (P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.19444 of 2012, whereby respondent was directed to take action as per law laid down by this Court for allotment of plots to the petitioners within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Upon notice short affidavit of Mr. Shakti Singh, HCS, Estate Officer, HUDA, Karnal dated 09.01.2015 has been filed in Court, wherein it is stated that the petitioners have been afforded due opportunities of hearing and after hearing both the sides, the Authority has passed speaking order

Annexure R-1 duly communicated to the petitioners whereby their claim for

allotment of plots in lieu of acquisition of their land for development and establishment of Section 13, Karnal has been rejected due to non availability of the plots and as such compliance of the order dated 28.09.2012 has been duly made and nothing survives in the present contempt petition.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present contempt petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
