In the writ petition bearing CWP No. 7148 of 2016 filed by
the petitioner, this Court vide order dated 21.04.2016 (**Annexure P-1**)
passed the following operative directions:-

*“In view of above, without commenting on the merits of
the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the
respondents to decide the legal notice dated 23.12.2015 (P-3)
of the petitioner by passing a speaking order, in accordance
with law, preferably within a period of three months from the
date of receipt of certified copy of this order. .”*

Upon notice, a reply has been filed wherein it is stated that in
compliance of the order dated 21.04.2016 (**P-1**), a speaking order dated
24.08.2016 (**Annexure R-1**), deciding the legal notice dated 23.12.2015,
has been passed and the same has been conveyed to the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action in the contempt is warranted, accordingly, present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.

However, if the petitioner is still aggrieved, he is free to challenge the above said order dated 24.08.2016 **(R-1)**.
