The petitioner had filed CRM-M No.458 of 2015 seeking directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.3 to 5. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 08.01.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the S.S.P., Sangrur (respondent No.4 therein) to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner expeditiously in accordance with law. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the allegations mentioned/levelled by the petitioner in his representation were found to be wrong and baseless by the S.I.T., vide its report dated 30.03.2015 (**Annexure R-1/T**) and S.S.P., Sangrur has passed a speaking order dated 03.04.2015 (**Annexure R-2/T**) in this regard.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel submits that the aforesaid directions passed by this Court have already been complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
