The petitioners have filed the present contempt petition as the respondents have violated the order dated 19.07.2006 (**Annexure P-2** collectively), passed by this Court in CWP No.9693 of 1989 and other connected petitions, which were filed by Union of India against the Award(s), passed by the Special Land Acquisition Collector, Amritsar.

Upon notice, reply has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the due benefits have been released to all the petitioners vide a Cheque bearing No.488516 dated 15.09.2016, total amounting to Rs.13,06,983/-. Details of the same are at **Annexure R-1**.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioners concedes that the present petition has become infructuous as the necessary relief has since been granted to the petitioners.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
