JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioners had filed CWP No.17024 of 1995 seeking directions to the respondents to regularize their services with all consequential benefits from the date of their joining as they had put 6 to 10 years of service on daily wage basis on the post of Mali/Beldar continuously without break. The said petition along with connected petitions were disposed of vide order dated 27.04.2016 (**Annexure P-2**) with a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioners' cases for regularizing their services in terms of the policy/instructions which fit their cases, that is, 07.05.1993 or thereafter, as the case may be. It was further directed that the consideration in the light of the order be completed within two months from the date of supply of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions passed by this Court have since been complied with.

In view of above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
