Learned State counsel submits that compliance of the order has been made subject to outcome of LPA No.2460 of 2017 which is still pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that consequential benefits have not been released to the petitioners. The petitioners are at liberty to move a detailed representation to the respondent authority. In case the petitioners are found to be entitled for said benefits, the same be released to them. If the petitioners are not found entitled for the relief as made out in the representation and as per order passed in the writ petition, a detailed speaking order be passed. In case the petitioners are still aggrieved by the order passed by respondent-authority, they are at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
