The contempt petition remained pending on various dates only on the ground that petitioner overstayed after expiry of period of parole, whereas learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is facing two jail trials for commission of offence.

Learned State counsel submits that it is a serious issue as the petitioner has misused the concession of parole.

The petitioner is already facing trial in two different jail offences and he will face the consequences after conclusion of the trial. The contempt has been filed for non-compliance of the order passed in Criminal Writ Petition No.1003 of 2016, whereby direction was issued to respondent-authority to reconsider the case of the petitioner within a period

of six weeks and same has been reconsidered.

Accordingly, nothing survives in the contempt petition and the same is dismissed accordingly.
