The petitioner/Part Time Sweeper in the Govt. Primary School, Jharli, Mohindergarh had filed CWP No.373 of 2015, seeking directions to the respondent authorities to decide her Legal Notice dated 19.09.2014. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 12.01.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the Director of Primary Education, Haryana to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner raised vide her Legal Notice dated 19.09.2014 and decide the same at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply by way of affidavit dated 14.02.2017 of Sh. M.L.Kaushik, Director, Secondary Education, Haryana has been filed, wherein it is submitted that the claim of the petitioner has been rejected vide speaking orders dated 06.05.2015 (**Annexure R-1**) and 24.01.2017

(Annexure R-2).

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
