The petitioner is a resident of Village Dehman, Tehsil & District Fatehabad and was constrained to file CWP No.18056 of 2014, as the eviction orders passed against Rangi Ram were not being enforced by the Panchayat by re-possession of the Panchayat's land, which was disposed of by the Division Bench of this Court vide order dated 03.09.2014 (**Annexure P-5**) with a direction to the Executing Authority to decide the pending execution application within three months. Since the needful within the stipulated time was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, an affidavit dated 23.02.2017 of Sh. Satbir Singh Jangu, Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Fatehabad has been filed, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to learned Counsel for the petitioner.

It is averred that the eviction orders have since been executed and

possession of the land measuring 5 Kanals being in unauthorized possession

has since been restored back to the Gram Panchayat, Dehman vide Rapat No.296 dated 02.05.2014. Thus, it is contended that the order dated 03.09.2014 (P-5) passed by this Court within the stipulated time stands complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
