Learned counsel for the respondent submits that order passed by this Court on 7.6.2016 in C.W.P. No. 12304 of 2016 has been complied with and the amount of gratuity as well as benefits of pension have been released to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the submission made by learned counsel for the respondent but submits that there is delay in releasing the payment and the petitioner is entitled for interest.

Since the order passed by this Court on 7.6.2016 has been complied with and the legal notice of the petitioner has been considered and benefits have also been released to him, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

As far as grant of interest on delayed payment is concerned, the petitioner is at liberty to move representation to the respondent-authorities and in case such representation is made within a period of one month from today, the respondent-authorities are directed to consider and decide the same within a period of two months thereafter.
