Learned counsel for the State submits that as per directions issued by this Court on 17.7.2014, order dated 18.12.2014 has been passed, which is annexed as Annexure R-1 with the reply filed by respondent No.2, whereas, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that two contradictory stands have been taken by respondents No. 1 and 2. It has been stated by respondent No. 1 in his reply that relevant record of the case has burnt whereas as per reply filed by respondent No. 2, claim has been rejected. No where it has been mentioned regarding acquisition of the land of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Deputy Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar to pass a speaking order within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In case, the petitioner is aggrieved by the order passed by respondent No.1
i.e. Deputy Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar or he is aggrieved in any
manner, he is at liberty to challenge the same.
