Notice of motion.

On the asking of court, Mr. Aditya Sharda, AAG Punjab, who is present in court accepts notice.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 08.02.2017 passed by writ court, operative part thereof reads as under:-

“8. Therefore in view of the law laid down that discharge of duties of a higher post an employee would be entitled to the pay commensurate to the said post, the husband of the petitioner was entitled to the same. It is held that the husband of the petitioner would be entitled to the arrears as flow from the direction of this court. The same be released to the petitioner with interest @ 6% from the due date till realization within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, in case the same is not released within the time as specified, the petitioner would be entitled to 9% interest on the amount so calculated and released.”

Grievance of the petitioner is that despite clear direction given

in the aforesaid order, same has not been complied with. According to him,

no appeal has been preferred by the respondents impugning the aforesaid order.

Petition is disposed of with the direction that another opportunity is granted to the respondents to purge the contempt. In case needful is not done within two week's from today, petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition. In such eventuality, this court shall consider imposition of exemplary costs.
