The petitioner/Sanitary Inspector had filed CWP No.13857 of 2015, seeking directions to the respondents to decide his Legal Notice dated 28.02.2015. The said petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 14.07.2015 (**Annexure P-1**), with a direction to the Director, Department of Local Bodies, Punjab to take decision on the Legal Notice dated 28.2.2015 issued on behalf of the petitioner by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. It is further ordered that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent has filed a speaking order dated 09.03.2017, wherein it is submitted that the pay of the petitioner has been fixed along with the benefits of ACP, as demanded in the Legal Notice dated 28.02.2015.

Learned Counsel for the respondent submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions passed by this Court stand complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned Counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
