There was a matrimonial dispute between Leena (petitioner) and her husband-Gaurav Malhotra, as also her in-laws. Since the police was not taking action on the criminal complaint filed by the petitioner, she filed a writ petition bearing CWP No. 21322 of 2015, which was disposed of vide order dated 06.10.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court, directing the police authorities to examine her representation dated 21.09.2015 and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Upon notice, an affidavit/reply of Director General of Police, Law and Order, Punjab, has been filed. Alongwith the said reply, a speaking order dated 25.11.2016 (**Annexure R-1**) has been appended, deciding the claim set up in the representation dated 21.09.2015.

Learned State Counsel states that directions contained in the order dated 06.10.2015 **(P-1)** passed by this Court, have been fully complied with, therefore, no further action is warranted in the present contempt petition, as the same has become infructuous.

In view of above, present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
