The petitioners herein along with others had filed CWP No.13066 of 2011 for quashing the order dated 14.06.2010, whereby pay of the petitioners had been reduced and re-fixed at lower stages. The said petition was allowed vide order dated 03.11.2012 (**Annexure P-2**), quashing the impugned order dated 14.06.2010 being contrary to the Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 and Haryana Civil Services (Assured Career Progression) Rules, 2008. It was directed that recovery, if any, effected from the petitioners on account of re-fixation of their pay on the basis of order dated 14.6.2010 be refunded to the respective petitioners within a period of three months from the date of passing of the order. It was also directed that the consequential benefits to the petitioners be granted within a further period of two months. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply has been filed asserting that the necessary relief has since been granted to the petitioners, subject to the outcome of SLP that has been filed by the State and is pending consideration.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
