This common order shall dispose of the aforesaid two contempt petitions as they emerge out of common facts.

The petitioners had filed the aforesaid writ petitions seeking directions to the respondents to regularize their services with all consequential benefits from the date of their joining as they had put 6 to 10 years of service on daily wage basis on the post of Mali/Beldar continuously without break. The said petitions along with other connected petitions were disposed of vide order dated 27.04.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) with a direction to the respondents to

consider the petitioners' cases for regularizing their services in terms of the policy/instructions which fit their cases, that is, 07.05.1993 or thereafter, as the case may be. It was further directed that the consideration in the light of the order be completed within two months from the date of supply of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that both the present petitions have become infructuous as the directions passed by this Court have since been complied with.

In view of above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petitions stand dismissed as infructuous.
