JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Raghubir Chand, on attaining the age of superannuation, retired w.e.f. 31.12.2011 from the rank of Senior Lab Attendant, a Class-III post. He filed a writ petition after five years of his retirement bearing CWP No. 2541 of 2016 seeking the relief of promotion, with retrospective effect from 26.11.1985 alongwith all consequential benefits, by amending his previous promotion order dated 02.01.1995. The said writ petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 15.02.2016 **(Annexure P-1)** with the directions to the respondents to pass a speaking order on his representation dated 08.08.2015 within three months.

Upon notice, a reply has been filed, wherein it is stated that in compliance of the order dated 15.02.2016 **(P-1)**, a speaking order dated

01.06.2016 (**Annexure R-1**) has been passed, whereby the petitioner has not been entitled to retrospective promotion as Senior Lab Attendant.

Learned State Counsel states that no further action in the present contempt is warranted.

In view of above, present contempt petition stands dismissed.
