Learned State counsel submits that compliance of the order has been made subject to outcome of LPA No.2460 of 2017 which is still pending.

The petitioner is at liberty to move a detailed representation to the respondent authority. In case the petitioner is found to be entitled for said benefits, the same be released to him. If the petitioner is not found entitled for the relief as made out in the representation and as per order passed in the writ petition, a detailed speaking order be passed. In case the petitioner is still aggrieved by the order passed by respondent-authority, he is at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
