The petitioner is a Govt. Contractor and had filed CWP No.14138 of 2016, seeking a direction for payment of the outstanding dues qua the work executed by him on the projects of Water Supply and Sanitation Department, Punjab. This Court vide order dated 20.07.2016 (**Annexure P-1**) disposed of the writ petition, directing the authorities to release the outstanding dues.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the parties submit that the present contempt petition has become infructuous in the light of the admissible dues have since been paid.
