The petitioner had filed CWP No.20465 of 2012 seeking promotion to the post of Assistant Manager w.e.f. 25.01.2011, the date from which his juniors were promoted. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 13.05.2016 with a direction to the respondents to promote the petitioner from the date his juniors were promoted i.e. 25.01.2011 as Assistant Manager and the financial benefits, which are due, be disbursed to him within three months from the receipt of certified copy of the order.

Upon notice, reply by way of short affidavit dated 03.02.2017 of Sh. Jagdish Parkash, General Manager, Punjab State Cooperative Agri. Development Bank Ltd. has been filed. Copy of the same has been furnished to learned Counsel for the petitioner.

In the reply, it is submitted that the aforesaid directions have since been complied with.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
