The petitioners, claiming themselves to be *gair marusi* tenants in the portion of the *shamlat deh* which was acquired, had filed CWP No.14116 of 2014, which was disposed of vide order dated 22.07.2014, directing the Land Acquisition Collector to forward their reference before the Reference Court.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that the present contempt petition has become infructuous as a reference before the District Judge, Karnal has since been forwarded on 21.01.2017.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
