The petitioner/Construction Company had executed works in Village Lambi, Tehsil Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and a sum of Rs.1,56,60,000/- was stated to be outstanding.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present contempt petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid amount has since been released by the Department concerned.
