DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Vide order dated 28.4.2016, CrI. Misc. No. M-14365 of 2016 filed by the petitioner was disposed of with a direction that if any complaint is made by the petitioner, the same shall be processed and disposed of, in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of aforesaid direction, the petitioner made a complaint to the police but no action has been taken thereupon and the order passed on 28.4.2016 has not been complied with.

Learned State counsel submits that an inquiry was conducted on the application moved by the petitioner and both the parties were asked to join inquiry and their statements were also recorded. In the inquiry, it was found that there is no danger to any human life. Learned counsel

further contends that Criminal Misc. Petition was filed only on the basis of apprehension that the petitioner is having genuine will, whereas, one Poonam Mahant is having a forged will. The petitioner is apprehending threat at the instance of said Poonam Mahant because he is pursuing his claim on the basis of genuine will.

Heard the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the documents available on the file.

While arguing the case, learned counsel for the petitioner has not brought anything on the record to show that the petitioner has availed any remedy and any case is pending at Amloh or he is to visit Amloh for any purpose.

There is nothing to interfere in the petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

However, if at any point of time, the petitioner thinks that he is having danger or threat from any side, he is at liberty to make representation to the concerned authority.
