Learned State counsel submits that he has sought instructions from the Director, Food and Supplies Department, Haryana. He has been instructed that all necessary steps are being taken for compliance of the order dated 6.4.2015 by the writ court. Needful shall be done at the earliest, in any case not later than two weeks.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. Petition is hereby disposed of. In case contempt is not purged within two weeks, petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of same. In such eventuality, apart from proceedings under the Act, this court shall also consider imposition of punitive costs, which shall not be less than Rs.1.00 lac and shall be liable to be deducted from the salary of the official(s) responsible for delay/non-compliance.
