AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has filed an affidavit of Shri R.K. Singla, Divisional Engineer, T/well Division, Punjab Water Resources Management Development Corporation Ltd., Malerkotla, according to which, the payments due to the petitioner have been released to him after deduction of the income tax. In Court, a cheque amounting to ₹ 6,63,431/- has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner. He further states that in case, there is any claim, which according to the petitioner is still pending with the respondents, he may approach Shri R.K. Singla, Divisional Engineer, T/well Division, Punjab Water Resources Management Development Corporation Ltd., Malerkotla, on 15.06.2017 at 11 AM, to reconcile his accounts. The claim of the petitioner shall be

considered by the said respondent in case he submit a representation to that effect and a speaking order passed thereon within a further period of 15 days. In case, some amount is still found due by the said respondent, the same shall be disbursed to the petitioner on or before 21.07.2017.

The present contempt petition stands disposed of with above observations granting the petitioner liberty to revive the same if the respondents do not make the remaining payment as they may assess and ultimately found to be due, by the date fixed above.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged subject to above.
