Petitioner-Smt. Sneh Lata Makkar was appointed as Mistress in Hindi prior to 19.02.1979 in the Education Department, Punjab. It is a conceded position that the posts of Master and Mistress prior to the said date carried the pay scale of Rs. 110-250. She (petitioner) claims to have improved her qualification by having acquired the Degree of Post Graduation in Hindi. She, thus, alongwith others had filed a writ petition bearing CWP No. 16335 of 1989, which was disposed of vide order dated 02.07.2013, directing that the petitioner was entitled to the benefit in terms of the notification issued in the year 1957, supplemented by the 1960 notification.

Upon notice, the respondent has filed a counter-affidavit, wherein it is stated that a speaking order dated 14.01.2016, deciding the

claim of the claimants including the present petitioner (Smt. Sneh Lata

Makkar) has been passed, and as per para Nos. 5 & 10 of the speaking order, the necessary benefit has since been granted and released.

In view of the above, this Court is satisfied that no further action is warranted, accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.

However, if the petitioner is still aggrieved, she is free to challenge the above said order dated 14.01.2016.
